

Launch of the IBM MORE website

The website will gather the intellectual outputs aimed to strengthen European key competences in education and learning of EFP through applications to boost the entrepreneurial spirit of migrants

IBM MORE is an Erasmus + KA2 funded project. The project began in September 2019 and will last two years. It involves four organisations from Belgium, Austria, Norway and Spain. This project's objective is to prevent the isolation of migrant entrepreneurs in a political economy promoting specific innovative resources.

IBM-MORE project aims to support VET teachers and trainers with innovative tools and methods to stimulate the innovation, digital, intercultural and entrepreneurship competencies of VET learners through APPs-based learning. This includes a pedagogical handbook for transferability in a European context.
